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DSA Reminder

It is not too late to start integrating your data into the state's system. If you do not already have a legal relationship to submit data to the state, send a completed [Data Sharing Agreement](#) to Kaitlin Ferrick.

Integrating data provides a meaningful, longitudinal view of your programs and outcomes. Providers, parents and residents can get a long-term view of children's progression and program effectiveness.

FAQ: I Haven't Reported - Where do I Start?

- First:** Determine locally which grantee staff member(s) will submit data.
- Second:** Find the submitting entity's code in [EEM](#).
- Third:** Already have MSDS access? Skip this step. Need to know your entity's authorized users? Contact CEPI. Need access? Send a completed [security form](#) to CEPI and wait for instructions.
- Congratulations!** You have completed the preliminary steps.

- End-of-Program 2018 MSDS [EC Collection](#) details:
- Mid-collection data quality snapshot: Aug. 2 (tentative)
 - Certification Deadline: Aug. 15 at 11:59 p.m. EDT
- The certification start date is before the end of the reporting period, which allows running of quality review (system data quality checks) before the mid-collection snapshot.
