1. The statement of service is furnished under the
2. This statement is furnished primarily for historical purposes in which the State is solely concerned. It is not to be used against the Federal Government. The law prohibits the furnishing of such information against the Government, except to the proper Government authorities.
3. Applications from individuals, other than historical records, should be denied and the applicant directed to apply to the custodian of the official records of the Armies of the United States for patriotic and philanthropic societies and associations of said society or association, and will not be made available indirectly as a basis for, or in the prosecution of, a claim.
4. Except as hereinbefore provided, all persons serving in the Army should be denied information from, or access to, records which would be made available to persons who might perpetrate offenses against the Government.
5. Except the data contained on the first four lines of the service record is prepared as far as practicable from the service record with other records, except where a discrepancy exists.
6. Some enlistment papers show age at enlistment in a different form as those on the enlistment paper.
