Subject: Statement of service of John James Corcoran.

1. Returned with the information that the official records at these Headquarters show that the above named man who was born January 14, 1889 at Geneva, New York applied for enlistment June 1, 1917 at R. S. Toledo, Ohio; that he enlisted and reported for active duty June 10, 1917 at M. B. Parris Island, S.C., and was honorably discharged July 18, 1917 while serving with Casual Company 1702, Quantico, Va., with character "Excellent".

2. Our records further show that he gave Toledo, Ohio as his former residence and that his service record card was sent to the Adjutant General of that state. There is nothing on the records of this office which would indicate that he was a resident of Michigan at the time he entered the service.
