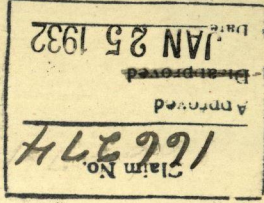

Reference is made to your request dated August 15, 1931, relative to the service record of Mr. Delphis J. Pelletier while in the Lighthouse Service, Department of Commerce.

The records indicate that Mr. Pelletier served on board the Lighthouse Tender Sumac as Seaman from May 3, 1917 through July 2, 1917, and from September 29, 1917 through January 31, 1919 as Seaman and First Class Fireman, and from April 19, 1919 through June 30, 1919 as First Class Fireman, on which date the Lighthouse Tender Sumac was returned to the service and jurisdiction of the Lighthouse Service. The Lighthouse Tender Sumac was transferred to the jurisdiction of the Navy Department prior to the time Mr. Pelletier entered on duty.

Mr. Pelletier was appointed Assistant Engineer at \$1260 on the Lightvessel No. 98 on March 24, 1921 and remained there until February 1, 1923, when he was made keeper at Beaver Island, Light Station, Michigan at a salary of \$660. While at this station he received the following promotions: \$900, effective July 1, 1924; \$1080, effective February 1, 1925; \$1140, effective July 1, 1925; \$1200, effective July 1, 1927, and \$1320 effective July 1, 1928. On October 1, 1928, he was transferred to Frankfort Pierhead Range, Lighthouse, Michigan, at a salary of \$1500, which position he still holds.
