These rates are embargoed and cannot be released to the media or any outside party before the data are delivered to the Michigan Legislature. To access your Graduation and Dropout Rates, please follow these steps:

- Log in to MI School Data at <https://www.mischooldata.org/> (the login button is on the upper left-hand side of the landing page) using your user name and password.
- Click on the Student Counts link on the left-hand side.
- Click on the Grad/Dropout Rate tab in the center of the page.
- Choose your ISD and district.
- Further filter the data using the Report Settings selections, and then choose View Results.
- To access student details in the report, click on the desired section of the bar graph OR click the Student Breakdown radio button at the top.

Note: You must be a MI School Data authorized user with a preview role to view the rates before they are released to the public.

- If you already have a MI School Data (or Data for Student Success) user name and password, you have access to secure data on the site. However, you may need to contact your local user administrator or [ISD technical contact](#) to request preview rights.
- If you do not already have secure access to MI School Data, please contact your local user administrator or [ISD technical contact](#) to request a login and password with preview rights.
