- [M-STEP](#). 2015-16 School year data are available to the public. The Michigan Student Test of Educational Progress (M-STEP) report shows student proficiency in ELA, math, science and social studies. Claim-Subscore data is available for users with secure access.
- [MI-Access](#). 2015-16 School year data are available to the public. The MI-Access report shows how students with cognitive impairments have scored on Michigan's alternative assessment test.
- [College Board SAT](#). 2015-16 school year data are available to the public. The College Board SAT report shows how students performed in the subjects of Evidence Based Reading and Writing and Mathematics.
