Additional data are available for the 2010-11 through 2013-14 high school graduation classes. The report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who enrolled in a college or university.
- **[24 College Credits](#)**. 2013-14 high school graduation class data are available. Additional data are available for the 2010-11 through 2012-13 high school graduation classes. The report shows how long it's taking for Michigan public high school graduates to accumulate 24 college credits.
- **[College Progression by Graduating Class](#)**. 2013-14 high school graduation class data are available. Additional data are available for the 2007-08 through 2012-13 high school graduation classes. This report shows how Michigan high school graduates are progressing in postsecondary education.
- **[College Undergraduate Enrollment](#)**. 2014-15 postsecondary enrollment year data is available. The report provides a profile of undergraduate students enrolled at Michigan colleges and universities.

- **[College Remedial Coursework](#)**. 2013-14 high school graduation class data update coming soon. The report shows the number of Michigan public high school graduates who took at least one remedial course after enrolling in a Michigan college or university the year after high school graduation.
- **[Student Pathways Aggregate](#)**. 2014-15 high school graduation class fall data and additional data for the 2007-08 through 2013-14 update coming soon. The report is a convenient, one click way for a high school to download a packet that provides college enrollment, credit accumulation, remedial coursework and progress data for its graduates.
- **[College Transfers](#)**. 2014-15 data update coming soon. The report shows the transfer patterns, demographics, and performance data for undergraduate students who transfer from one college or university to another.
- **[Student Pathways](#)**.** 2014-15 data update coming soon. The report shows student-level information on college enrollment, coursework, cumulative credit, program and award information, and grade point averages (GPAs). New this release is an accompanying secondary Career and Technical Education (CTE) program enrollment history file.
