The IHE Request for UIC Collection will be open through February 28, 2014.

The collection will open again from **April 1, 2014 through June 13, 2014**. You are required to include the unique identification code (UIC) in each student's academic record when you upload it to the Student Transcript and Academic Record Repository in May 2014. You may obtain the UIC from the student's electronic transcript, student search in the Michigan Student Data System or through the IHE Request for UIC Collection.
